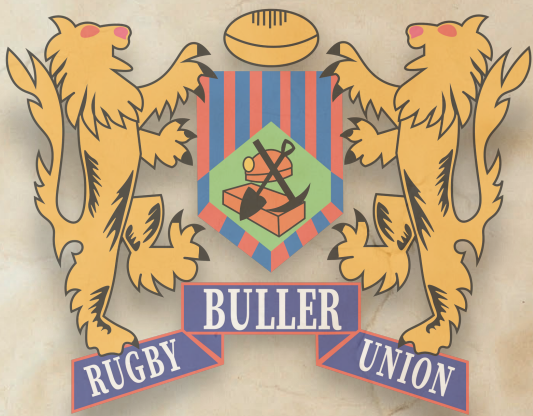

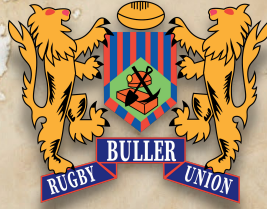

BULLER PERSONALITIES. P. Mumm (Ngakawau), the regular full-back for several seasons, is playing better than ever this year. His goal kicking has been outstanding. J. Duncan (Old Boys), played for Buller in one game in 1921 and in all games this season. In 1933 South Island Rugby team. A great hooker. G. Anderson (Rovers), captain, appeared in many All Black trials, emergency in 1919 South Island team and several combined Buller-Coast sides. A fine forward. W. Mumm (Ngakawau), 1949 All Black, N.Z. fifteen 1948 and 1949 South Island Rep. in 1945-1946, 1947 and 1949. First played for Buller in 1921 and has not missed a season since. R. Burrow (Old Boys), has worn the Buller jersey last two seasons. A good attacking winger who is showing improved all round form this year. B. Tyler (Ngakawau), has previously represented Buller. He is probably playing better this year, showing good form against Canterbury and Coast recently. I. Tyler (Ngakawau) is making a good come back to the Buller team this year and in his two appearances so far this season has justified his inclusion. J. McArthur (Ngakawau) has represented Buller for several seasons, and is one of the team's most solid backs, especially on defence. He has also represented Buller at soccer.	WEST COAST PERSONALITIES. F. Gargich (Excelsior), aged 23, 1921 5th, 21 11th. Played for South Island and Rest of N.Z. last season. Very speedy and a good scorer. A. Lindbom (Star), aged 21, 1st 15th, 6th 16th South Island winger in 1923 and emergency in 1924. South Island Colts team and in All Blacks trials. G. Nelson (Star), captain, aged 33 years, 1927 6th 11th. Has played for Coast during last 11 years. Three times in Buller-Coast combined teams, 1923 South Island Minor Union side, 1921 and 1923 All Black trials. K. Foster (St. Mary's), aged 26 years, 1926 4th 6th. Appeared in major games last year for the first time and twice this season. A rugged type of packman. T. Bird (Blaketown), aged 24 years, 1921 10th, 6th 11th. Played in five games for Coast in 1924 and three in 1925. Again playing well this season. N. Williams (United), aged 26 years, 1927 6th, 5th 6th. Played once for Coast last year as five-eighth and twice this season. Smart attacking back. J. Lindbom (Cobden), aged 23 years, 1927 8th, 5th 6th. First played for Coast in 1921, combined Coast-Buller team in 1925-1927, 1928, Seddon Shield Districts 1926 and All Black trials 1922. Many grand games played at Westport. E. Stratford (Star), 21 years, 1927 7th, 5th 6th. This young five-eighth has yet to appear for Coast, has been emergency. Has been showing good form in Club games.
